

Potholes ! The chase is on...



Help us find and repair potholes by informing your borough's office.

Winter is coming to an end, yet the last vagaries of winter weather continue to do damage to our roads and cause potholes to appear.

To maintain the roadways in good condition, the City constantly repairs holes and cracks in the pavement. During the next few weeks, and weather allowing, more than twenty road maintenance teams will be at work.

Let us know !

Our road network is longer than 2550 kilometers. Even though our city workers' vigilance increases this time of year, your

cooperation is well appreciated.

If you notice that the condition of the pavement in a certain area calls for urgent attention (a big hole, a large crack, a caved in metal grate of the sewer system), please advise your borough's office. After regular office hours, you can dial **418-641-6383**. In the following days, a team will make its way to proceed with repairs.

Spring-cleaning

The City is now getting ready for its annual spring-cleaning of roads, sidewalks and outdoor parking lots. If weather conditions are favorable, this vast operation will start early April to end around mid-May. In order to allow the maintenance teams to do their job properly, **there will be parking restrictions** in certain neighborhoods on days or nights where cleaning operations are carried out. The City will install road signs informing of dates and schedules of any planned spring-cleaning operations. These signs will be installed along the road side or areas

where parking will be prohibited, and this, 24 hours prior to the works to be carried out. If weather conditions don't allow our teams to proceed with the planned cleaning operations, they will simply be postponed.

Towing Info
