Before throwing out bulky waste items by putting them in the street, please contact your borough's office to find out about collection arrangements.

The near arrival of summer rimes with "big clean up", for us to enjoy the summer season to the fullest! To get rid of residues or any kind of garbage (old objects, construction material, etc.), Québec City offers several services.

Green waste collection

From May 2nd to 27th, you can deposit your weeding residues and lawn clippings in orange or transparent bags. These bags will be picked up the same day as for regular waste collection.

Ecocenters

Seven ecocenters are available to help you dispose of branches, construction material, old objects, etc.

Collection of bulky waste items

To benefit from this particular service, please communicate with your borough's office and we will come and pick up old furniture, mattresses, household appliances, etc.

Free distribution of trees

Where and when?

The free distribution of trees will be held on **Saturday, May 14th**, from 8:30 am on and until supplies are exhausted. First come, first serve!

Two thousand trees are offered

This year, two thousand trees will be distributed. You can choose from five species: serviceberry, crabapple, Japanese lilac, Tatarian maple and red maple. The trees measure about 1.5 meter and will be delivered in pots of 3 gallons (11 liters).

You will be asked for a proof of residence (drivers licence or tax bill) and there

is a limit of only one tree per residence.
