The period to apply for a summer job at the City of Quebec has started.

**Are you a high school, a college or a university student? The City of Quebec and its numerous partners have over 1200 summer jobs to offer to you.**

Some of these jobs pertain to the sector of leisure activities and culture, including aquatics as well as the program **Vacances-Été** ("Summer Holidays"). These jobs will be offered to the candidates that are best qualified after a selection process starting in the month of March. Selection of candidates will end when all positions are filled.

Other more "general" jobs pertain

to different domains or fields of study: secretarial studies, civil engineering, architecture, chemistry, police training and more. The selection of the candidates will be done randomly. The closing date to apply for one of these jobs will be **March 31st**.

Candidates that have been employed by the City of Quebec in 2009 will have priority over others applying for the same job, but only if their contribution was considered satisfactory and if they the delay fixed for inscription has been respected.

detain a special permit.

Warning to the offenders : the inspectors are vigilant and could issue a **150\$ fine** (plus court expenses).
