INSURANCE IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS

1. Commercial general liabilities

The standard wording referred to is that in effect on the effective date of the policy or, where applicable, on the date of the last renewal immediately preceding the occurrence of the damages giving rise to the claim.

N.B.: The standard form BAC2100 wording to which this endorsement is specifically subject contains limitation of coverage amount clauses that have the effect of reducing the amounts available when claims occur during the policy period.

However, liability arising from the preparation or approval of maps, plans, surveys, expert reports, studies, specifications or estimates is excluded.

The deductible stipulated in the policy, where applicable, does not apply to the holder, its employees, or the members of the municipal council, its executive committee and the borough councils.

2. Non-owned automobile liability

Coverage is governed by the standard wording approved by the Inspector General of Financial Institutions of the Province of Quebec, as applicable at the time of the loss.

Except with respect to the reduction of limits following the occurrence of a covered loss, the insurer undertakes to give the holder's clerk, by registered or certified mail, at 2 rue des Jardins, Québec (Québec) G1R 4S9, 30 days' prior notice of any reduction or cancellation of said insurance.

All other clauses of the policy(ies) remain unchanged.
