

Our Vision

Through its international relations, a strategic lever for development, Québec City bolsters its influence and attractiveness while learning from other cities around the world for the benefit of its citizens and its community.

An invaluable tool

- For boosting a city's influence and development. International relations are especially crucial when serving and defending the interests of a capital city like Québec, the cradle of the French language and culture in North America and a UNESCO World Heritage Site;
- For showcasing our cultural, tourism, economic and scientific assets, as well as our quality of life, in partnership with various organizations. In turn, attracting talent, partners and visitors worldwide who contribute to the vibrancy and reputation of our city;
- For sharing expertise and experience at a time when cities around the globe must overcome unprecedented challenges to ensure sustainable and inclusive development.

- International relations showcase the city and the institutions and businesses that make it flourish. They also create value for the services, products and ideas they develop and seek to export;

- They encourage regional partners to work hand in hand and take a more strategic and collaborative approach.

- Québec's businesses, higher learning institutions and visionary entrepreneurs and scientists who are eager to develop new markets for their products, services and ideas;
- Local creators and cultural industries that export outstanding French-language content and products;
- Our prestigious UNESCO World Heritage Site and Creative City of Literature designations and our world-class tourism offering, which we want to be more sustainable and diversified.

2. Québec LEARNS

Cities around the world all face the same kind of challenges and must all be part of the solution. However, they have limited resources to deal with increasingly complex and pressing challenges, such as adapting to climate change, ensuring sustainable mobility and transportation or maintaining social cohesion. **Cities must work together**—as they do not have the time and the resources to reinvent the wheel or tackle these issues alone. Cities have a duty to inspire and be inspired to innovate.

- Stay abreast of innovations and learn from the successes and mistakes of other cities
 that are also working to optimize infrastructure, programs and services to make them more
 sustainable and accessible;
- Show solidarity by sharing our best practices and experiences with cities and partners who are also eager to learn from our successes and lessons;
